February 18, 1899 in Hutchinson, Kansas. His
father was Lewis Edward Walker and his
mother was Anna Elizabeth Leger Walker.
He did a lot of traveling while young. Some
of the places were: Des Moines, Iowa, Kansas
City, Mo., Manitou, Colo., Los Angeles, Calif., Corpus
Christi, Texas & then to Austin, Texas where he
spent most of his childhood & young man-
hood. While in Los Angeles he attended the
Los Angeles military academy where he was the
youngest student in attendance. He attended
both public & private schools while in
Austin. He received his degree from the Univ.

Texas in Business Administration.
